A message from the Headteacher

To begin the week, a number of staff attended the Requiem Mass of 'Amazing Grace' Speakman on Monday afternoon. A wonderful celebration of Grace's life, beautifully put together and well attended. An *extra special* well done to Robert Speakman who read the bidding prayers out very clearly and reverently. Under these circumstances, we all felt you did extremely well, reading at your twin sister's funeral. We are all so proud of you Robert. Then of course we had the snow!

I would like to take this opportunity to briefly share with you the considerations we make before taking the decision to close the school. These are: firstly, if the temperature in the building drops; secondly if the food provisions do not reach us and finally if the staff are unable to get into school then the decision will be made to close the school for the day. The fact that it is snowing does not mean school closure. At all costs, we will endeavour to keep school open if it is safe to do so. Unfortunately this decision cannot be made until I have an accurate understanding of staff's situation and number of children arriving in school. We are fortunate to have a brilliant team of dedicated staff who do their very best to get into school as carefully and as safely as they can so that we can maintain our service to children and families. Thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter on Wednesday morning. The fact that other schools have closed is irrelevant because each school has different types of site risks and may have a larger number of staff travelling from further distance to work and a whole host of other factors to consider. We believe it to be good practice to consult the Safety Officer at Wigan as well, when making such big decisions that have a huge impact on the routines and work patterns of our families. If ever the weather warning is a RED alert then I will close the school with immediate effect and notify you straight away. I would like to reiterate once more that at all cost everyone's safety both children and parents has to come first and great care needs to be taken when travelling to school on these such days. Taking your time is crucial and being late is almost anticipated on Snow days. So please do not worry about that. As always thank you for your continued support.

Last night we had a lovely Sacramental meeting where the children worked well with their families preparing for their First Holy Communion. Thank you once again to those parents and grandparents who attended – it really makes a difference and is so important for the children.
